### Lancaster Ultra-Graphics Announces New Scholarship Opportunity for Local Students

Lancaster, PA -- Lancaster Ultra-Graphics, Inc. headquartered in Landisville, Pennsylvania, recently established an educational scholarship through the Print and Graphics Scholarship Foundation (PGSF) *Website: [www.gatf.org](http://www.gatf.org)*. Named the Lancaster Ultra-Graphics, Inc. \ L. Fred Husson Scholarship, this new educational resource is a renewable yearly scholarship in the amount of \$1,000. The scholarship, which is under the administration of the Susquehanna Litho Foundation, is the second scholarship established through PGSF in collaboration with the Susquehanna Litho Foundation.

The scholarship is for a full-time student pursuing a degree at an accredited college or university in the field of Printing or Graphic Arts that meets the academic requirements of PGSF. Preference will be given to a resident of Lancaster County if all other criteria are equal.

Fred Husson, one of the founding members of the Susquehanna Litho Club, *Website: [www.sl.org](http://www.sl.org)* served as the campaign chairperson for the recent \$175,000 Capital Campaign of the Susquehanna Litho Foundation. Husson served as President of the Litho Club in 1961. In 1987, Husson founded Lancaster Ultra-Graphics after 28 years in pre-press, working at local printers including Rudisill Printing Co., R.R. Donnelley, Intelligencer Printing, and Wagaman Bros. *Website: [www.ultragraphics.com](http://www.ultragraphics.com)*

In 1992, Husson's son, Steve Husson, became President of Lancaster Ultra-Graphics. Founded as a conventional pre-press service organization, Lancaster Ultra-Graphics has a unique history serving printers, advertising agencies, and in-house corporate advertising / marketing departments. In May of 2000, Ultra-Graphics acquired the prepress business of Alphabet Graphics, thus combining the two largest digital pre media companies in Central Pennsylvania.

In October of 2001 Ultra-Graphics moved into its new 12,500 sq. ft. facility located at 1900 McFarland Drive in Landisville. Current services include short-run digital and full variable color printing, large format inkjet printing for trade show, photographic, and display graphics, film imaging, catalog layout services, fine art reproductions, digital photography, high resolution scanning and image manipulation, and digital proofing.

The Susquehanna Litho Foundation was established in 1998 to raise funds for and grant scholarships to those pursuing education in the printing and graphics arts professions. Staffed entirely by volunteers, the Foundation continues to promote careers and the highest standards in its industry. The SLF was chartered as a Nonprofit, Public Foundation under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
